NAPA VALLEY

Our 2001 Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits a deep, dark purple color with a subtle blue rim. Its intense blackberry/boysenberry aromas give way to dusty Valrhona chocolate and pure varietal fruit. Velvety mouth feel is punctuated by a plush blend of tobacco and anise, with well-integrated notes of licorice and asphalt adding a sophisticated and complex layer of flavor and texture. This rich, polished wine is texturally seamless, smooth and long on the palate, and exquisitely balanced.
