BROWN ESTATE 2018 DUPPY CONQUEROR WHITE

Our Duppy Conqueror label represents a lighthearted wing of our Brown Estate wine family. The name is taken from a surrealist drawing made by our Uncle Buntin in the 1970s, an excerpt of which graces the bottle. In Afro-Caribbean cultures a duppy is a menacing ghost or spirit, and a duppy conqueror essentially is one capable of vanquishing such forces. In Jamaican folklore the term connotes—and conjures—superhero powers. We hope these wines will have a similar effect.

Eye: Flaxen straw

Nose: Baked pineapple, banana gratin, trumpet flowers, fresh cut lawn, mandarin orange, bay leaf, sea spray

Palate: Rich, dense, round, and persistent

Cellar life: Drink now through 2022

Pairing inspirations: Oysters on the half shell, linguine with clams, mussels and frites
